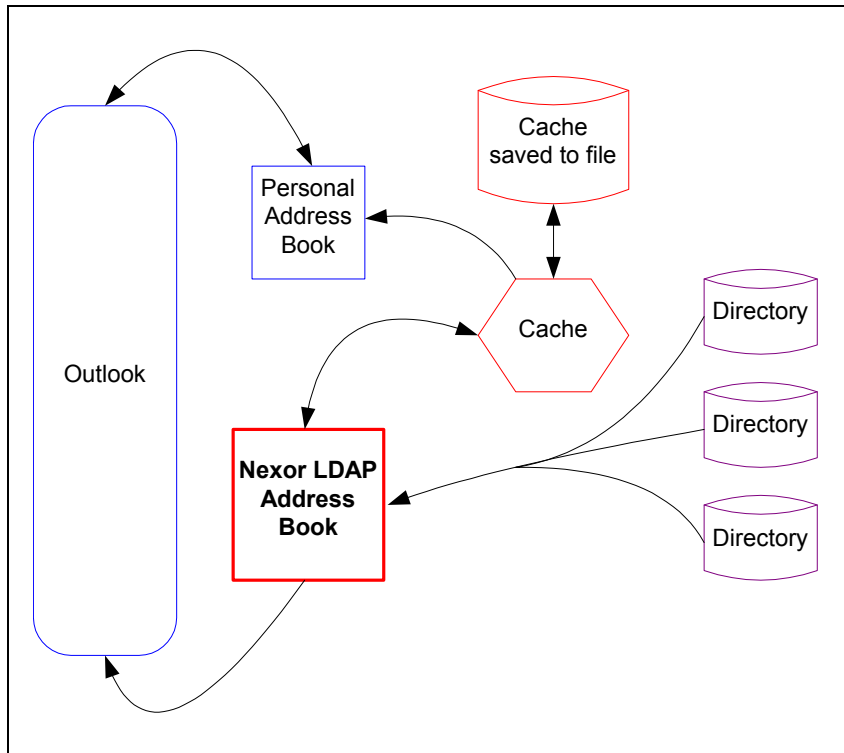


# Introduction

The Nexor LDAP Address Book provides an interface to an X.500 or LDAP Directory. It can be used with Microsoft Outlook, Nexor Defender for Outlook and Nexor S/MIME Security to provide individuals with access to centrally maintained directories.

Figure 1 shows a typical scenario with the Nexor LDAP Address Book providing the interface between LDAP compliant directories and Outlook (or another MAPI-enabled application). The arrows indicate the flow of information between the various components.

The primary role of the Nexor LDAP Address Book is to enable users to choose recipients when composing messages. It can be configured to return a variety of addresses, which can consist of a number of address types from the standard SMTP and X.400 to custom formats such as ACP127 and locally created types (for example, 'Nexor').

In addition, it can retrieve and display other information, including telephone numbers, location information, role occupants and alternative contact details.
